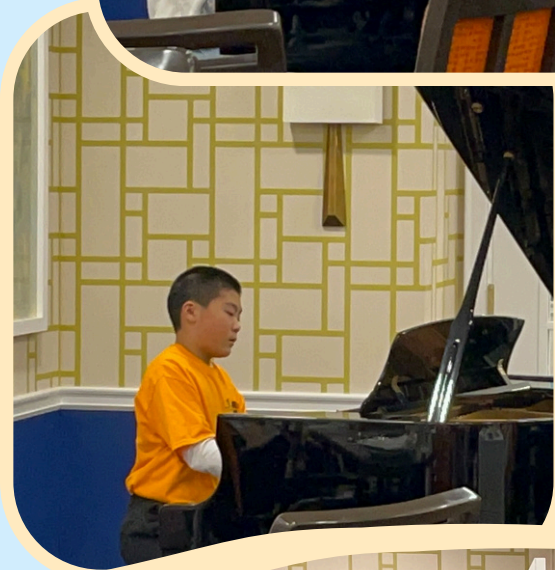

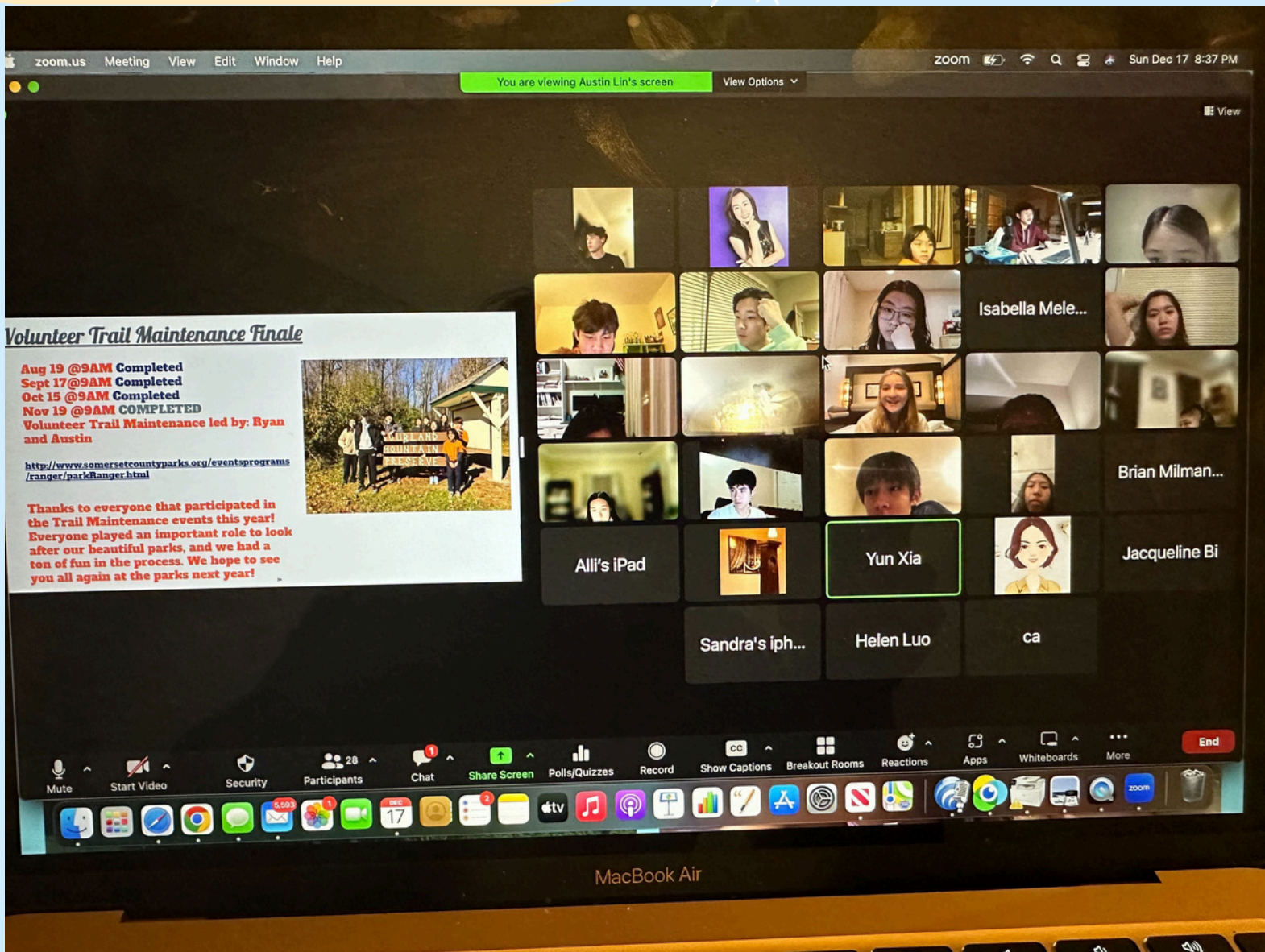
# December Senior Center Concert
