Every Saturday from 9 to 11 A.M., IYC volunteers took care of garden beds and planted and harvested a variety of vegetables. During most of our visits, we weeded several garden beds by using shovels and other tools to help pull out the weeds. One time, we cleared an entire bed clustered with weeds that were almost as tall as us! Over the course of the summer, we harvested squash, okra, zucchini, carrots, Asian pears, collard greens, and tomatoes. We also separated garlic cloves and cleaned garlic that was already harvested. These vegetables have been donated to local food banks for those in need of food.


